ORDER

No. 76/OR-HP/2004—WHEREAS, Ms. Radhika Ekka a contesting candidate at the election to the House of the People, 2004 held from 20—Sundargarh (S.T.) Parliamentary Constituency has failed to lodge any account of her election expenses, as required by the Representation of the People Act, 1951 and the Rules made thereunder ;

AND WHEREAS, Ms. Radhika Ekka has not furnished any reason or explanation for the said failure even after due notice of the Election Commission ;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission is satisfied that the said candidate has no good reason or justification for the said failure ;

NOWHEREFORE, in pursuance of Section 10-A of the said Act, the Election Commission hereby declares Ms. Radhika Ekka to be disqualified for being chosen as and for being a member of either House of the Parliament or of the Legislative Assembly or Legislative Council of a State/Union Territory for a period of 3 years from the date of this order.
