### AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of section 12 read with clause (d) of sub-section (1) of section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No.15372-Ii/I(BH)29/97/LE., Dated the 4th December 1997.

“Whether the action of the Management of the Talcher Co-operative Agricultural and Rural Development Bank Ltd., in terminating Shri Anukula Sahoo, Night Watchman from his services w.e.f. 20th January 1996 is legal and/or justified ? If not what relief workman Shri Sahoo is entitled to ?”

2. The concerned workman is absent on repeated calls. No steps taken on his behalf. The case is posted for hearing. No prayer is also made by the either the parties to adjourn the case to some other date for hearing. On perusal of the case record, it is seen that, the workman has been remained absent since 13th March 2003. Since the concerned workman is absent, no Award is possible.
