S.R.O. No. 355/2006—Whereas the association known as Communist Party of India (Maoist), with the avowed objective to overthrow the lawfully established Government by means of force and violence and through terrorist activities involving the use of fire arms and explosives has indulged in various unlawful activities;

And whereas its front organisation namely, Kui Lawenga Sangha, subserving the interests and objectives of the Communist Party of India (Maoist), has been indulging in the following unlawful activities, namely :—

(i) Subserving the interests and objectives of the Communist Party of India (Maoist), whose avowed objective is to overthrow the lawfully established Government by means of force and violence through terrorist activities, involving the use of fire arms and explosives;

(ii) Inciting gullible tribals to take to violence against the Government established by law;

(iii) Storming the jails for killing their opponents and releasing the other inmates;

(iv) Organising and indulging in forcible grabbing of lands owned privately by the agriculturist;

(v) Organising and indulging in forcible harvesting of crops on the lands cultivated and owned privately by the agriculturist;

(vi) Attacking and killing the persons opposed to their illegal activities;

(vii) Holding "Prajā Courts" under threats and duress in contravention of the judicial system established by law and punishing the alleged culprits and delivering illegal verdicts;

And whereas the Government of Orissa are of the opinion that for the aforesaid reasons the association, namely, Kui Lawenga Sangha, for its objectives interferes with the administration of law or with the maintenance of law and order and that its activities constitute a danger to the public peace.

And whereas the Government are of further opinion that because of the said activities of this association, namely, Kui Lawenga Sangha, it is necessary to declare the said Sangha as unlawful with immediate effect.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the India Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1908 (Act of 1908), the State Government hereby declare the Kui Lawenga Sangha to be an unlawful association with immediate effect.
