### NOTIFICATION

The 20th June 2006

**S.R.O. No. 358/2006**—Whereas the association known as Communist Party of India (Maoist), with the avowed objective to overthrow the lawfully established Government by means of force and violence and through terrorist activities involving the use of fire arms and explosives has indulged in various unlawful activities;

And whereas its front organisation namely, Bal Sangam, subserving the interests and objectives of the Communist Party of India (Maoist), has been indulging in the following unlawful activities, namely :—

- (i) Subserving the interests and objectives of the Communist Party of India (Maoist), whose avowed objective is to over-throw the lawfully established Government by means of force and violence through terrorist activities, involving the use of fire arms and explosives;
- (ii) Recruiting children and brain washing them by teaching C.P.I. (Maoist) ideology of violence;
- (iii) Preaching hatred to children of tender age against the Government established by law;
- (iv) Using children for collecting the information on the movements of police forces for passing it to the Communist Party of India (Maoist) outfits;
- (v) Indoctrinating the children and inducting them into the armed squads or guerilla army of Communist Party of India (Maoist) and also using them to indulge in mindless violence;

And whereas the State Government are of the opinion that for the aforesaid reasons the association, namely, Bal Sangam interferes and has for its object interference with the administration of law and with the maintenance of law and order and its activities constitute a danger to the public peace;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Indian Criminal Law Amendment Act, 1908 (Act 14 of 1908), the State Government hereby declare the Bal Sangam to be an unlawful association with immediate effect.
