S.R.O. No. 15/2006—The Commission of Inquiry, consisting of Shri P. C. Pathy, Chairman, Arbitration Tribunal, Bhubaneswar was appointed vide Notification No.2583/C, dated the 24th June 2005 of Home (Special Section) Department, Government of Orissa published in the extraordinary issue No.1004, dated the 24th June 2005 in *Orissa Gazette*, to enquire into the incident of alleged confrontation on 16th October 2001 between the Police and the Members, Bar Association of Puri in the premises of District and Sessions Judge and in the Hall of the Bar Association, Puri and other matters specified in the said Notification with a request to submit the report of the inquiry within 6 (Six) months.

It is considered necessary in the public interest to extend the term of the Commission of Inquiry. The Government have, therefore, ordered in exercise of the power conferred by section 3 read with sub-section (1) of section 5 of the Commission of Inquiry Act, 1952 (60 of 1952) that the terms of the Commission be extended for a further period of 4 (Four) months and 6 (Six) days i.e. upto 30th April 2006 and that the following amendments be made in the said notification.

In the said notification for the words “Six Months” appearing in the consequential portion, the words “Ten Months and Six Days” shall be substituted.
