3. The appointment of any Member of the Committee may be terminated, after holding inquiry, by the State Government, if—

- (a) he/she has been found guilty of misuse of power vested under this Act ;
- (b) he/she has been convicted of an offence involving moral turpitude, and such conviction has not been granted full pardon in respect of such offence ;
- (c) he/she fails to attend the proceedings of the Committee for consecutive three months without any valid reason or he/she fails to attend less than three-fourth of the sitting in a year.

4. The Committee shall function as a Bench of Magistrates and shall have the powers conferred by the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 on a Metropolitan Magistrate, or, as the case may be, a Judicial Magistrate of the First Class.

5. The Committee shall meet at such times and shall observe such rules of procedure in regard to the transaction of business at its meetings, as may be prescribed.

6. The meeting of the Committee shall be convened by the District Social Welfare Officer of the concerned District.
