THE CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED TRIBES) ORDER (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2008

(ACT No. 14 OF 2008)

*An Act further to amend the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order, 1950 to modify
the list of Scheduled Tribes in the State of Arunachal Pradesh*

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-ninth year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title. 1. (1) This Act may be called the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order (Amendment) Act, 2008.

Amendment of Part XVIII of Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order, 1950. 2. In the Schedule to the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order, 1950 in Part XVIII relating to the State of Arunachal Pradesh for entry 4, the following entry shall be substituted, namely :— C. O. 22.

“4. Nyishi”.

THE MATERNITY BENEFIT (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2008

(ACT No. 15 OF 2008)

An Act further to amend the Maternity Benefit Act, 1961

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Fifty-ninth year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the Maternity Benefit (Amendment) Act, 2008.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the Central Government may by notification in the official Gazette, appoint.

Substitution of new section for Section 8.

2. In the Maternity Benefit Act, 1961, for Section 8, the following section shall be substituted, namely :—

Payment of medical bonus.

“8. (1) Every woman entitled to maternity benefit under this Act shall also be entitled to receive from her employer a medical bonus of one thousand rupees, if no prenatal confinement and postnatal care is provided for by the employer free of charge.

(2) The Central Government may before every three years, by notification in the official Gazette, increase the amount of medical bonus subject to the maximum of twenty thousand rupees.”.
