ORDER

The 28th February 2008

No. 3390—ENV-I-87/2007(Pt.)-F&E.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986), read with Notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Environment & Forest (Department of Environment, Forest & Wildlife) No. SO-152(E), dated the 10th February, 1988 and Rule 4 of the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986, the State Government do hereby direct that following amendments shall be made in the Notification of the Government of Orissa in the Forest & Environment Department No. 10140-F&E., dated the 25th June 2007, namely :—

AMENDMENT

In the said notification, after paragraph 5-B, the following paragraph shall be inserted at the end.

“5-C. The Municipal Commissioners/Executive Officers of different Municipal Corporation/Municipalities/Notified Area Councils of the State shall enforce the ban on polythene bags under 20 (twenty) microns thickness in their respective jurisdiction with necessary assistance from concerned District Magistrates and Collectors. They shall make requisition for services of Executive Magistrates, if required for seizure of carry bags below 20(twenty) microns.”
