NOTIFICATION

S.R.O. No. 355/2009—In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 33 of the Orissa Forest Act, 1972 (Orissa Act 14 of 1972), the State Government do hereby declare that the land situated in village Tumbei under Bonai Tahasil of the district of Sundargarh mutated and transferred for compensatory afforestation purpose against the diversion of forest land for Mining of Iron and Manganese Ore by M/s. Bonai Industrial Co. vide Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests order in their Stage-II approval letter No. 8—108/1996-FC., dated the 17th April 2003 under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, the limits of which are specified below and the area of which is 16.798 ha. shall be Protected Forests with effect from the date of issue of Notification and shall be known as “Tumbei Protected Forest”.
