The function of the aforesaid State Level Co-ordination Committee will be as follows :

- To review the situation of rabies, its prevention and control
- To review the vaccination of dogs and their sterilization
- Management of human rabies cases
- Licensing of stray dogs
- Ensure intradermal inoculation of anti-rabies vaccine

The above Committee will meet once in three months to discuss and evolve strategy for controlling stray dogs and prevention and control of rabies.
