RESOLUTION

The 14th December 2009

SUBJECT—Guidelines for operation of Welfare Fund Scheme for Diploma students for Study Allowance to economically backward meritorious students.

The Welfare Funds Scheme was introduced from the Academic Session 2006-2007 for the students admitted to Diploma Courses with a view to provide them financial assistance in case they face financial difficulty to complete the Professional Courses because of death of father/ financing guardian vide Industries Department Resolution No. 18020-I., dated the 30th December 2008.

In addition to that Government has been pleased to extend this facility of Welfare Funds Scheme for Diploma students for Study Allowance to economically backward meritorious students as per following guidelines :—

(2) A students whose father's income is below Rs.1.20 lakhs from all sources will be eligible under this scheme.

(i) A sum of Rs. 3,000 will be paid to each eligible candidate.

(3) 100 candidates will be awarded from 1st year students.

(i) Only first Semester common branches are eligible.

(ii) Merit list will be prepared on the basis of marks secured in the First Semester Examination from first 500 merit students.

(4) 100 candidates will be awarded from 2nd/ 3rd year students as per the distribution as given below :

(i) Merit list will be prepared on the basis of mark secured in 3rd /5th Semester Examination.

(ii) A branch existing in a single institute will be not considered.

(5) Modalities of operation of this scheme will be as per Industries Department Resolution No. 18020-I., dated the 30th December 2008.

The above prescribed guideline for operation of Welfare Scheme shall come into force with effect from the Session 2009-2010.
