NOTIFICATION

The 19th February 2009

S. R. O. No. 77/2009—The following 2 (two) Private High Schools appearing at Sl. Nos. 184 and 185 in the list of 1294 High Schools were notified vide School & Mass Education Department Notification No. 3325, dated the 20th February 2004 to receive Block Grant with effect from the 1st January 2004. Block Grant could not be released in favour of these two High Schools as similarly situated Private High Schools were not considered for Block Grant. The Government in Schools & Mass Education Department, after careful consideration have decided that these two Private High Schools are on the same footing of the Private High Schools notified vide School & Mass Education Department Notification 2819, dated the 10th February 2009. Accordingly these 2 (two) Private High Schools are eligible to receive Grant-in-Aid (Block Grant) as Aided Educational Institutions with effect from the 1st April 2008 subject to condition that the schools will fulfill all the eligibility criteria as per rules within a period of 3 (three) years failing which the Director, Secondary Education, Orissa will withdraw their recognition following due process of Law.
