ORDER

The 30th June 2010

No. 2851—Ele.(GP)-1/2010-SEC. —Whereas, the State Election Commission vide Notification No. 2353-SEC., dated the 31st May 2010 have laid down the schedule for holding by-election to the offices of Sarapanch and Ward Members including Sarapanch of Bharuamunda G.P., Makhapadar G. P. and Ward Member of Ward No. 13 of Godal G. P. under Sinapali Block in the district of Nuapara;

Whereas, on the perusal of report of the Collector, Nuapara communicated vide his Letter No.114-Res., dated the 25th June 2010 and Letter No. 120-Res., dated the 29th June 2010 it has been observed that the B.D.O.-cum-Election Officer, Sinapali has grossly violated the election procedure by not attending the scrutiny of nominations on the date fixed by the Commission and thereby vitiating the election process.

Now, therefore, the State Election Commission in exercise of powers vested in it by virtue of Article 243-K of the Constitution of India read with Rule 92-E(1) of the Orissa Grama Panchayat Election Rules, 1965 directs that the schedule for by-election in respect of Sarapanch, Bharuamunda G.P., Makhapadar G.P. and Ward No. 13 of Godal G.P. under Sinapali Block in the district of Nuapara notified vide Notification No. 2353-SEC., dated the 31st May 2010 is hereby cancelled from the stage of scrutiny of nomination until further orders.
