NOTIFICATION

The 3rd November 2010

S.R.O. No. 472/2010—In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 33 of the Orissa Forest Act, 1972 (Orissa Act 14 of 1972), the State Government do hereby declare that the land situated in village Kinaloi and Langbahal under Rengali Tahasil of the district of Sambalpur mutated and transferred for compensatory afforestation purposes against the proposed diversion of forest land for establishment of Aluminium Smelter & Captive Power Plant Project by Aditya Aluminium (A Division of M/s Hindalco Industries Limited) vide Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests orders in their Letter No. 8-27/2009-FC., dated the 10th November 2009 under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, the limits of which are specified below and the area of which is 44.8877 Ha. shall be Protected Forests with effect from the date of issue of the Notification and shall be known as “Kinaloi-Langbahal Protected Forest”.
