ORDER

The 3rd May 2010

No. 2656—IV(A)-SM.-101/2010-SM.—In exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (4) of Section 21, read with Sections 23B and 24 of the Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation) Act, 1957 (67 of 1957), the State Government do hereby authorise the Police Officers not below the rank of Sub-Inspectors of Police, functioning within the area of their respective Police Stations in the districts of Sundergarh, Keonjhar and Mayurbhanj to ;

- (i) seize any mineral, tool, equipment, vehicle and such other things which are liable to be seized under sub-section (4) of Section 21 and search such mineral, document or thing under said Section 23B; and
- (ii) enter and inspect any mine and do other acts as provided under said Section 24.
