RESOLUTION

The 4th June 2012

SUBJECT— Introduction of common qualification for the post of Classical (Sanskrit) Teachers in Government, Fully Aided, Block Grant and Recognised High Schools of the State with one scale of pay.

In School & Mass Education Department Resolution No. 17542-SME., dated the 5th September 2011 principles of fixation of pay of Classical (Sanskrit) Teachers in Government, Fully Aided, Block Grant and Recognised High Schools of the State possessing revised common qualification was prescribed. Subsequently certain difficulties have been pointed out by different District Education Officers as well as by the Utkal Sanskruta Sikshyaka Mahasangha in regard to fixation of pay prescribed in Para 8(iv) of the said Resolution.

After careful consideration Government have been pleased to decide that the fixation of pay prescribed in Para. 8(iv) of the said Resolution shall be modified/revised to the extent indicated below :

Fixation of pay of Classical (Sanskrit) Teachers.	On fixation of revised common qualification as per Para. (i), the Classical (Sanskrit) Teachers possessing the said common qualification shall be entitled to the scale of pay at par with Trained Graduate Teachers Scale of Pay. The pay of such Classical (Sanskrit) Teachers shall be fixed notionally under Rule 74(b) of the Odisha Service Code with effect from the date of possessing revised common qualification. The actual financial benefit shall be from the 1st January 2006.

The quantum of Block Grant of Classical (Sanskrit) Teachers of Block Grant High Schools possessing the revised common qualification shall be determined at par with the Trained Graduate Teachers of same High Schools under Block Grant fold in accordance with GIA Order, 2004 read with Amendments made thereafter from time to time by Government with effect from the 5th September 2011, i. e. the date of issue of Resolution No. 17542-SME., dated the 5th September 2011.

This Resolution will come into force with immediate effect.

This Resolution is issued with the concurrence of Finance Department vide their U.O.R. No. 12-PCC., dated the 18th April 2012.

ORDER— Ordered that the Resolution shall be published in an Extraordinary issue of the *Odisha Gazette*.
