No. 21816—FIN-TRY-Rule-0016/2012-F.—As part of e-governance initiative, it has been decided by the Odisha Public Service Commission (OPSC) to adopt the online submission of application form with offline payment of examinations fees which will expand the capacity of the Commission in conducting large number of examinations in a short time and will benefit the candidates. The Odisha Computer Application Centre (OCAC), Technical Directorate of Information Technology Department will render necessary assistance to the Commission for implementation of the software involving online submission of the application form. State Bank of India will be the designated Bank for deposit of the examination fees in offline mode.

2. Fees so collected in different branches of State Bank of India Pan-India will be pooled in a designated Bank account of OPSC maintained with SBI.

3. The SBI Secretariat Branch will upload the e-scroll relating to examination fees to the Cyber Treasury, Bhubaneswar for accounting on T+2 basis.

4. The accounting, reporting and reconciliation of e-Receipt pertaining to examination fees collected by OPSC through Cyber Treasury shall be made as per the procedure outlined in F.D. Resolution No. 3571F, dated the 31st January 2011. However, all other existing procedures for submission of accounts to A.G. (A & E), Odisha as well as reporting to the RBI will remain unchanged.

This will take immediate effect.
