THE REPATRIATION OF PRISONERS (AMENDMENT) ACT, 2011

(ACT No. 6 OF 2011)

An Act to amend the Repatriation of Prisoners Act, 2003

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-second Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Act may be called the Repatriation of Prisoners (Amendment) Act, 2011.

Amendment of Section 5 of Act 49 of 2003.

2. In the Repatriation of Prisoners Act, 2003, in Section 5, in subsection (2), in Clause (c), for the words “martial law”, the words “military law” shall be substituted.

THE STATE BANK OF INDIA (SUBSIDIARY BANKS) AMENDMENT ACT, 2011

(ACT No. 7 OF 2011)

An Act further to amend the State Bank of India (Subsidiary Banks) Act, 1959

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-second Year of the Republic of India as follows :—

Short title and commencement.

1. (1) This Act may be called the State Bank of India (Subsidiary Banks) Amendment Act, 2011.

(2) It shall come into force on such date as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.

Amendment of Section 2.

2. In Section 2 of the State Bank of India (Subsidiary Banks) Act, 1959 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act),—

38 of 1959.

(i) in Clause *(b)*, sub-clause *(ii)* shall be omitted ;

(ii) in Clause *(c)*, sub-clause *(ii)* shall be omitted ;

(iii) in Clause *(d)*, sub-clause *(ii)* shall be omitted.

Amendment of Section 3.

3. In Section 3 of the principal Act, clause *(b)* shall be omitted.
