Subject—National Level Common Management Admission Test (CMAT) 2012 introduced by the AICTE for admission in all management programmes.

No. 225—I-TTI-62/2012-I—The All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) with a mission to reduce the burden of the students in attending to multiple examinations for admission to management programmes has launched the 1st National Level Common Management Admission Test (CMAT) 2012 for facilitating institutions to select suitable students for admission in all management programmes approved by AICTE for the year 2012-13.

The initiative has been taken to address the issue of physical, mental and financial stress being imposed on the students through number of entrance examinations being followed by the institutions for admission into all Management Programmes in AICTE approved institutions based on the relevant judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

The Common Management Admission Test (CMAT) 2012 will be conducted Online in 61 cities from 20th February to 28th February 2012 and scores awarded will be used for admission in the Post Graduate Management Programmes both at Degree & Diploma level at national level for the year 2012-13.

The AICTE has requested to inform all institutions conducting MBA programme to register free of charge Online at the **Website [www.aicte-cmat.in](http://www.aicte-cmat.in)** and for use of CMAT 2012 score for admission into all management programmes in the AICTE approved institutions in the State for Academic Session 2012-13.

In pursuance of the above request made by the AICTE, the State Government have been pleased to decide that the CMAT-2012 score card will be used for admission to a specific percentage of seats of all the management institutions of the State following the provisions of the Odisha Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fee) Act, 2007. The

Institutions and the students are hereby informed for Online Registration through the above Website of the AICTE by the 22nd January 2012 for using the score card of CMAT-2012 and for effecting admissions.
