### NOTIFICATION

The 31st May 2013

No. 11419—WCD-CW-Misc-0199/2013-W.&C.D.—In pursuance to the powers conferred under Rule 68 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Odisha Rules, 2002 and its Amendment in the year 2009 the Government have been pleased to modify in the constitution of State Level Selection Committee for selection of members of District Juvenile Justice Boards and Child Welfare Committees in the Districts. Constituted vide Notification No. 10455-W.C.D., dated the 23rd June 2012 as follows:—

Terms and Conditions :

1. The Committee will select and recommend a panel of names to the Odisha State Child Protection Society (OSCPS) and Women and Child Development Department. For selection as members of the District Juvenile Justice Board (JJB) and District Child Welfare Committee (C.W.C.) as and when required under the Act.
2. The Selection Committee shall take into consideration the applications received duly recommended by the District Magistrates in this regard while recommending names for selection of members of the Board or Committee.
3. The Selection Committee shall also prepare a panel of names for each Board or Committee to fill in vacancies, which may arise, during the tenure of the Board or committee, according to Rule 69(3) (a).
4. In the event of a vacancy in the Board or Committee, the District Child Protection Unit shall inform the State Child Protection Unit or State Government for filling up such vacancy.
5. State Government in W & C.D. Department shall fill the vacancies on the basis of the panel of names recommended by the Selection Committee.
6. The Selection Committee shall meet quarterly to discuss about the selection procedure, nominations reviewing the list of panel, filling the vacancies, making investigations on complaints, etc.
7. If required on request by the State Government the Selection Committee may, hold necessary inquiry and recommend to the State Child Protection Unit (SCPU) or the State Government regarding termination or appointment of a member. In the event of a complaint received against any member of the selection committee, the Government shall cause an enquiry and take action as deemed proper.
8. The minutes of every meeting of the Committee shall be documented and sent to State Child Protection Unit (SCPU) or Odisha State Child Protection Society (OSCPS) and to Women and Child Development Department.
9. The tenure of the Committee shall be a period of five years from the date of notification referred above.
10. Notification No. 10455-W.C.D., dated the 23rd June 2012 is modified to this extent.
