### NOTIFICATION

The 1st October 2013

**S.R.O. No. 621/2013**—In exercise of the powers conferred under Section 33 of the Odisha Forest Act, 1972 (Odisha Act 14 of 1972), the State Government do hereby declare that the following land situated in Village Katada under Chhendipada Tahasil of the district of Angul mutated and transferred for compensatory afforestation purpose against the already approved diversion of forest land of 17.240 Ha. for coal mining and dumping of overburden in Village Golagadia and Malibrahmani under Chhendipada Tahasil of Angul district by M/s Monnet Ispat and Energy Ltd. in their allotted Utkal B2 Coal Block vide Government of India, Ministry of Environment & Forests, Eastern Regional Office letter in their final approval No. 5-ORC 070/2008-BHU, dated the 21st July 2011 under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, the limits of which are specified below and the area of which is 42.91 acres or 17.369 Ha. shall be Protected Forests with effect from the date of issue of the Notification and shall be known as “Katada Protected Forest”.
