### NOTIFICATION

The 26th October 2013

No. 10903—ME-III-14/2013-P.—With a view to augmenting employment opportunities for the unemployed youth in the State, the High Power Employment Mission was constituted under the Chairmanship of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, Odisha vide P & C Department Resolution No. 5476/P., dated the 31st March 2005. An Executive Body of the Mission was also constituted under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary, Odisha in order to oversee implementation of policy decisions taken by the High Power Employment Mission. Moreover, various Self-Employment Programmes (SEPs) are being implemented by some Development Departments. The P & C Department was monitoring these Self-Employment Programmes on monthly basis.

The State Government after careful consideration have been pleased to decide as follows :

1. The Employment and Technical Education and Training Department (E & TE and T) will extend Secretarial Assistance to the High Power Employment Mission and Executive Body of the Mission in place of Planning & Co-ordination Department.
2. The Employment and Technical Education and Training Department will collect pending Utilization Certificates against Grant-in-Aid placed with Odisha State Employment Mission Society and interest accrued thereon from time to time from the OSEMS and submit the same to A. G. (A&E), Odisha and LTAP Section, P & C Department as the case may be. The A. G. (A&E), Odisha may be requested to make necessary book adjustment accordingly.
3. The Employment and Technical Education and Training Department will monitor target and achievement under various Self-Employment Programmes implemented by different Departments on monthly basis instead of Planning & Co-ordination Department.
