NOTIFICATION

No. 4674—IF(A)-Misc.-2/2013-F&E.—Consequent upon reorganisation of Forest Field Establishment vide F&E Department Notification No. 13220/F&E, dated the 8th August 2003, the headquarters of two Divisional Forest Offices had been kept outside their territorial area of jurisdiction.

Sambalpur (North) Division comprise of territorial area of Jharsuguda Revenue District but its headquarters have been kept at Sambalpur.

Likewise headquarters of Puri (WL) Division is functioning at Bhubaneswar instead of Puri which affects the co-ordination with district administration, frequency of monitoring and supervision of Range Offices along with effectiveness of enforcement activities.

Besides, PCCF (WL) & CWLW has proposed to shift the headquarters of Bhadrak WL Division from Chandabali to Bhadrak for better co-ordination with district administration.

After careful consideration of the above matter and in partial modification of this Department Notification No. 13220/F&E, dated the 8th August 2003, Government have been pleased to order that :—

- (i) The headquarters of Sambalpur (N) Division shall be at Jharsuguda
- (ii) Sambalpur (North) Division is renamed as Jharsuguda Forest Division and Sambalpur (South) Division as Sambalpur Forest Division.
- (iii) The headquarters of Puri (WL) Division shall be at Puri
- (iv) A Camp Office of the DFO, Bhadrak (WL) Division shall function at Bhadrak. The DFO will attend the Camp Office at Bhadrak three days a week. The headquarters of the Bhadrak (WL) Division shall however continue at Chadabali.

This change of headquarters of the Division shall come into force from the date of actual shifting of office.
