- **S.R.O. No.** 488/2014—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Odisha is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Odisha Service Code, namely:—
 - 1 (i) These rules may be called Odisha Service Code (Amendment) Rules, 2014.
 - (ii) They shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from the 28th June 2014.
- 2. In the Odisha Service Code, in Rule 71, (i) Clause (a), excluding the first provisos thereto, shall be substituted by the following Clause, namely:—
 - "(a) Except as otherwise provided in the other clauses of this rule the date of compulsory retirement of a State Government servant on superannuation shall be the date on which he attains the age of 60 (Sixty) years subject to the condition that a review shall be conducted in respect of the Government Servant in the 55th year of age in order to determine whether he should be allowed to remain in service up to the date of the completion of the age of 60 (Sixty) years or retired on completing the age of 55 (Fifty-five) years in public interest."
 - (ii) after Clause (a-1) the following Clause shall be inserted, namely:—
 - "(a-2) Notwithstanding anything contained in Clause (a) of Rule 71, the date of compulsory retirement of an Allopathic Medical Officer belonging to Odisha Medical and Health Services cadre under Health & Family Welfare Department and an Allopathic Insurance Medical Officer under Labour and E. S. I. Department on superannuation, shall be the date on which he attains the age of 62 (Sixty-two) years".
