OFFICE ORDER

No. 13951—VE (PP&T)-13/2014-Elec.—The Home (Elections) Department, vide Order No. 5719, dated the 6th April 2014 and Order No. 7849, dated the 18th May 2014 have decided that the rate of *exgratia* compensation to the families of person on election duty who will die, while being on election duty or to the personnel who sustains grievous injury leading to permanent or temporary incapacitation whether by accident or any other means arising out of and in course of General Election, 2014 as follows:—

After careful consideration Government in Home (Elections) Department have been pleased to allow the same rate of *ex gratia* compensation to the families of person on election duty who die or to the personnel who sustain injury leading to incapacitation during the Bye-election for 13-Kandhamal PC. (period for the 19th September 2004 to 20th October 2014).

The other provisions of this Department Order No. 5719, dated the 6th April 2014 and 7844, dated the 16th May 2014 shall remain same. This has been concurred in by the Finance Department vide their UOR No. 168/CS-III, dated the 16th October 2014.
