### NOTIFICATION

The 28th April, 2014

**S.R.O. No.177/14**— Whereas the draft rules further to amend the Orissa Aided Educational Institutions' Employees' General Provident Fund Rules, 1983 was published as required by sub-section (1) of section 27 read with sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Orissa Education Act, 1969 (Orissa Act 15 of 1969), in the Extraordinary issue No.2347 of the *Odisha Gazette* dated the 20th December, 2012, in the notification of the Government of Orissa in the School & Mass Education Department No. 31588-I-SME(G)-211/2012/SME., dated the 17th December, 2012 as S.R.O. No.650/2012, inviting suggestion or objections from all persons likely to be affected thereby, till the expiry of a period of thirty days from the date of publication of the said notification in the *Odisha Gazette*,

And, whereas, no suggestion or objection has been received in respect of said draft by the State Government;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 27 read with sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the said Act, the State Government do hereby make the following rules to amend the Orissa Aided Educational Institutions' Employees' General Provident Fund Rules, 1983, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Odisha Aided Educational Institutions' Employees' General Provident Fund (Amendment) Rules, 2014.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 2005.

2. In the Orissa Aided Educational Institutions' Employees' General Provident Fund Rules, 1983, after Note-2 to rule-4, the following proviso shall be added, namely:—

“Provided that these rules shall not apply to the employees appointed on or after the 1st day of January, 2005 to services and posts in Non-Government Aided Educational Institutions either temporarily or permanently”.
