In order to enhance the employability of youth through competency and to prepare educated employable and competitive youth for various sectors of economy, Government after careful consideration have been pleased to introduce Vocational Education at Secondary stage.

Initially, the trades like Automobile and Information Technology & Information Technology Enabled Services (IT & ITES) has been decided to be started in 30 Schools in the State.

The Board of Secondary Education, Odisha is declared as Examination and Certification Body for the purpose. Vocational Education Course will be an Optional Subject as level-I for class-IX and level-II for class-X from the academic session, 2015-16 as provided under the National Vocational Education Qualification Framework (NVEQF).

The State Project Director, Odisha Madhyamik Shiksha Mission (OMSM), RMSA is designated as Nodal Officer for implementation of the scheme at secondary level.
