RESOLUTION

The 27th December 2014

SUBJECT—Reconstitution of Technical Advisory Committee for Irrigation Projects

In view of State's perspective to increase the irrigation coverage, enhance the scope and its objects, Government have been pleased to reconstitute the Technical Advisory Committee (T.A.C.) for Irrigation Projects comprising of the following Members :—

(11) Any other Member co-opted by the Chairman for special reasons.

2. The terms of reference of the Committee shall be as follows:—

- (i) To give technical clearance to all the Irrigation Project [Major, Medium, Minor (Flow & Lift)] creek irrigation projects, in-stream storage structures including ERM Projects from State's perspective and Road Projects under the new Scheme Irrigation Road Construction & Improvement Scheme (IRC&IS).
- (ii) To provide solution for complex design and construction problems
- (iii) To scrutinize revised estimate of the project as a whole
- (iv) To scrutinize the estimate of dams, tunnels, penstocks, gates, power houses and any other structure costing not less than rupees three crores.
- (v) To examine any work not covered by sanctioned estimate and estimates involving excess over 10% of the sanctioned estimate.
- (vi) To examine purchase of machinery and equipment involving expenditure more than Rs. 10.00 lakh.
- (vii) To review sequence of construction with available outlay for best results and consider any other item, Chief Engineers/Chief Engineer and Basin Managers/Chief Construction Engineers would like to.
- (viii) To scrutinize planning aspects of extension projects.

3. The concerned Chief Engineer and Basin Managers/Chief Engineers/Chief Construction Engineers/Director (Technical), OLIC shall send their proposals to the Member-Secretary of the Committee. Views of the OWPO, P.P.F. & I and DR & QC units will be obtained by the Member-Secretary prior to placing it before the T.A.C.

4. The Committee shall meet on a quarterly basis, preferably during March/June/September and December on a suitable date, as fixed by the Chairman and furnish their recommendations to the Government, whose decision will be final.

5. The Superintending Engineer, Rural Works (in-charge of PMGSY) shall be a Member of the T.A.C. convened to consider the Road Projects under the new Irrigation Road Construction & Improvement Scheme (IRC & IS).

6. This supercedes the Resolution No. 18198, dated 21st July 2011 and No. 31498, dated 9th December 2013.

ORDER—Ordered that the Resolution be published in the extraordinary issue of *Odisha Gazette* and copies of the same forwarded to all Department of Government/all Heads of Department/all Members of the Committee/Accountant General, Odisha/Deputy Accountant General (Works), Odisha, Puri/Chairman, Central Water Commission, Government of India, New Delhi.
