No. 7716—FE-FE3-FE-0119/2015-F&E.—As per the provision contained in Rule 27 of the Odisha Subordinate Forest Service (Method of Recruitment and Conditions of Service of Forest Guards) Rules, 1998, for relaxation of Rule 23 Government after careful consideration of the proposal of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Odisha have decided to relax the Rule 23 of the Rule in respect of appointment of 600 Forest Guards, the process for which has been initiated in 2013-14 as follows :

Provisions of Rule	Relaxed as
23 The selected candidates shall undergo a training course for a period of six months.	The selected candidates shall be appointed first and their services will be utilized. Thereafter, they will be deputed for training batchwise on the basis of seniority. They will be on probation till one year after successful completion of the training.

This will be an one time relaxation in view of the fact that it will take within two years to complete the training of 600 Forest Guards as the existing capacity for training of 240 candidates in six months.
