No.11908. XII-SME-(Trg.)07/2015/SME. The NCTE Regulations, 2014, Norms and Standards for Bachelor of Education Programme leading to the Bachelor of Education (B.Ed. Degree) stipulates that the B.Ed. Programme shall be of a duration of two academic years. Similarly, the Norms and Standards for Master of Education Programme leading to Master of Education (M.Ed. Degree) stipulates that the M.Ed. Programme shall be of a duration of two academic years including field attachment for a minimum of four weeks and research dissertation.

Accordingly, the State Government have been pleased to enhance the duration of existing B.Ed. & M.Ed. Programme to two years with effect from the academic session 2015-16 .

The State Council of Educational Research and Training is entrusted with the task of developing the curriculum for the two years B.Ed. and two years M.Ed. Programme after taking into consideration the curriculum frame work developed in NCTE Regulation, 2014, the existing State curricula revised in 2012 and curriculum of Regional Institute of Education in practice.

The SCERT is also authorized to ensure the approval of the newly developed curriculum by the State Universities and its introduction from the academic session 2015-16.
