### **NOTIFICATION**

The 27th July, 2016

No.26065–HOME-JAIL-MISC-0010/2015/JLS.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections 1 & 27 of Section 59 of the Prisons Act, 1894 (9 of 1894) in its application to the State of Odisha, the State Government do hereby make the amendment further to rule 25(b) of Odisha Jail manual, Volume-1 as follows:—

“25(b) As regards purchase of medicines, the Superintendents of Circle Jails, District Jails, Special Jails, Juvenile Jails, Female Jails and Open Air Jails are allowed to exercise their financial powers to the extent of Rs. 2500 (Rupees Two thousand five hundred only) and Rs. 1200 (Rupees One thousand two hundred only) per day in case of purchase of life saving drugs and general drugs respectively. The Superintendents of Special Sub-Jails and Sub-Jails are allowed to exercise their financial powers to the extent of Rs. 1000 (Rupees One thousand only) and Rs. 500 (Rupees Five hundred only) per day in case of purchase of life saving drugs and general drugs respectively”

This supersedes Home Department Notification No. 29637/JLS., dated the 8th June, 2007 in respect of rule 25(b) of Odisha Jail Manual, Volume-1.
