RESOLUTION

The 14th July, 2017

Sub : Constitution of State Level Crisis Management Committee.

In pursuance of the directives in Section 301 of Chapter III of the Union War Book – 1993 each State and Union Territories Administration had to prepare, in peace times, Internal Security Scheme for the entire State/ UT, capable of being implemented at short notice and to bring them into force in case there is any subversive activity or Internal civil disturbances. Accordingly, the Integrated Internal Security Scheme for the State of Odisha was prepared. As per provisions made in Para. XX of the said scheme, a State Level Crisis Management Committee, for dealing with internal emergencies relating to public order, terrorist outrage, mutiny, migration, exodus, infiltration, etc. is reconstituted as follows in partial modification of Home Department Resolution No.4242/C., dated the 28th August, 2002.

2. The Committee shall meet as often as considered necessary at the State Headquarters, Bhubaneswar.

3. The Committee shall normally handle all crisis situations and advise and guide the District Committee (comprising of the District Magistrate, Supdt. of Police and other connected members to be nominated by the District Magistrate) as and when necessary.

4. The Committee shall inform all developments to the Central Committee and minor operation of contingency plan based on Internal Security Schemes for Towns, Districts and the State in the event of crisis situation.

ORDER

Ordered that the Resolution be published in the Extraordinary Official Gazette and 50 (fifty) copies of the same be made available to this Department.
