NOTIFICATION

The 21st February, 2017

S.R.O. No.78/2017— The following draft of certain rules further to amend the Odisha Aided Educational Institutions' (Non-Government Fully Aided Primary School Teachers') Retirement Benefit Rules, 1986, which the State Government propose to make in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 27 of the Odisha Education Act, 1969 (Odisha Act 15 of 1969), is hereby published as required by sub-section (1) of Section 27 of the said Act for the information of all persons likely to be affected thereby and notice is hereby given that the said draft will be taken into consideration on or after the expiry of a period of thirty days from the date of publication of the said notification in the *Odisha Gazette*.

Any suggestion or objection which may be received by the Commissioner-*cum*-Secretary to Government, School & Mass Education Department from any person in respect of the said draft before expiry of the period so specified shall be taken into consideration by the State Government.

DRAFT

1. Short title and commencement:— (1) These Rules may be called the Odisha Aided Educational Institutions' (Non-Government Fully Aided Primary School Teachers') Retirement Benefit (Amendment) Rules, 2017.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on 1st day of September, 1988.

2. In the Odisha Aided Educational Institutions' (Non-Government Fully Aided Primary School Teachers') Retirement Benefit Rules, 1986, for sub-rule(2) of rule 8, the following clause shall be substituted, namely :—

“(b) The family of a pensioner or an employee who died on or after the first day of April, 1982 and otherwise eligible to receive pension under the Odisha Aided Educational Institutions' (Non-Government Fully Aided Primary School Teachers') Retirement Benefit Rules, 1986, shall be entitled to get family pension as admissible. The financial benefit shall be made effective prospectively from the date of commencement of this amendment of the rules”.
