### ADDENDUM

The 25th July, 2018

No. 16169–VIII(B)-SME(X)-81/2016/SME.— Considering the huge gap between availability of teachers and requirement of teachers on Govt. Secondary Schools due to hindrances in filling of the vacancies, like unavailability of ST & SC category candidates and litigations in different courts, the “Teacher on Call Scheme” was introduced vide this Department Resolution No.16330/SME., dated the 17th August, 2016, in order to overcome the situation by way of engaging retired Teachers.

Similar situation arise in case of fully Aided High Schools as well as upgraded and taken over High Schools of the State for which Govt. have been pleased to decide to extend benefits of the “Teacher on Call Scheme” to these Schools.

As agreed to by the Finance Department, the following changes to the prevailing provisions of the Scheme along with the parameters are added to the said Resolution ;

1. The scheme is operative for the academic year 2018-19 and will be reviewed by S&ME Department before March 2019 for further continuance.
2. Retired Teachers can be chosen from all the above category of High Schools including Block Grant High Schools.
3. Para.2(c) be modified with reference to the remuneration of Guest Teachers to Rs.12,000/- per month subject to other criteria as mentioned in the said Resolution.
4. Para. 3(b)(c)(d)(e) of the Resolution No.16330/SME., dated the 17th August, 2016 be substituted and the following Para. 3(b) may be added.

“3(b)-DSE(O) will release funds (with due verification) to the DEOs who will make payment of the Guest Teachers engaged in the process through their Bank Accounts.”

All other provisions of the S&ME Department Resolution No.16330/SME., dated the 17th August, 2016 remain unchanged.

This has been concurred by the Finance Department vide their U.O.R No.97/SS-I dated the 20th June, 2018.

**ORDER**

Ordered that the Resolution be published in the next issue of the *Odisha Gazette* and copies thereof be extended to all concerned with 100 spare copies for reference.
