No.5551–SME-NGHS-NGHS-0068/2017/SME.— It was stipulated in this Department Order No.20040/SME., dated the 22nd October, 2017 read with this Department Order No.6108/SME., dated the 20th March, 2018 and Order No.12533/SME., dated the 4th June, 2018 that the eligible employees willing to accept the benefits under the Odisha Education (Payment of Grant-in-Aid to the High Schools, Upper Primary (M.E.) Schools, Sanskrit Tols and Madrasas) Order, 2017 & Amendment Order, 2018 are to submit their willingness in Plain Paper to the Secretaries of their respective Managing Committees by the stipulated time.

Now, it is seen that some of the eligible employees of these Educational Institutions receiving Grant-in-Aid under GIA Order, 2013 have not yet submitted their willingness to their respective Secretaries of the Managing Committees within the stipulated time. In the meantime several grievances have come to the notice of the Government not to insist for affidavit / written intimation as a condition to avail the benefit of GIA Order, 2017 and Amendment Order, 2018.

In view of the orders dated the 21st August, 2018 of Hon'ble High Court of Orissa passed in W.P.(C) No.11014 of 2018 filed by the M.C. of Harihareswar Panchayat High School & Others and in similar bunch cases, after careful consideration, Government have been pleased to delete the clause – 2 and connected Para warranting consequential action thereto under *Annexure – A*, clause - 3 under *Annexure – B* and clause – 3 under *Annexure – C* of this Department Order No.20040/SME., dated the 22nd October, 2018.

All other terms & conditions shall remain intact.
