## AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department vide memo No. 17088 (4)-L.E., dated the 5th December 1996 in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (5) of Section 12 read with clause (c) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 have referred the matter in dispute to this Court vide Labour & Employment Department Notification No. 8007-L. E., dated the 18th July 1985 read with Notification No. 7559-L. E., dated the 27th June 1995 for adjudication.

“Whether the termination of services of Shri Prasanna Kumar Mohapatra, Binder, by Shri Raimohan Mangaraj, Employer of M/s Annapurna Press, Rajarani Nagar, Bhubaneswar with effect from the 29th July 1994 is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief he is entitled ?”

2. The workman is absent on repeated calls. No steps taken on his behalf. Similarly the management is also absent and no steps taken on its behalf. The perusal of the case record clearly emerges that both the management and the workman are absent. In such view of the matter a ‘No Dispute Award’ is passed accordingly.
