AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department vide Memo. No. 11341(5)-L.E., dated the 25th August 1995 in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (5) of Section 12 read with clause (c) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 has referred the matter in dispute to this Court vide Labour & Employment Department Notification No. 8007-L. E., dated the 18th July 1985, read with Notification No. 5779-L. E. dated the 27th June 1995 for adjudication.

“Whether the termination of services of Shri Melachha Pradhan, Cadre Secretary by the Secretary, Khurda Central Co-operative Bank, Khurda with effect from the 14th February 1990 is legal and/or justified? If not, to what relief he is entitled ?”

2. The concerned workman is absent on repeated calls. No steps taken on his behalf. The representative of the management is present . The case is posted today for hearing. No prayer is also made by the workman to adjourn the case to some other date. On perusal of the case record, it is seen that the workman has been remained absent since the 4th May 2004. Since the workman concerned was absent. Hence a no dispute Award is passed accordingly.
