AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No. 12795—li/1(BH)-37/1997-LE., dated the 13th November 1998 :—

“Whether the termination of Shri Sanatan Behera, Cook-*cum*-Attendant from services with effect from the 6th December 1994 by the management of Bhalukchua Primary School Hostel is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief he is entitled to ?”

2. The workman is absent on repeated calls. No steps taken on his behalf. Similarly the management is also absent and no steps taken on its behalf. The perusal of the case record clearly emerges that both the management and the workman are absent repeatedly. In such view of the matter, a No Dispute Award is passed accordingly.
