AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their order No. 9986—li/1(B)-48/1996-LE., dated the 11th August 1997.

“Whether the termination of service of Shri Dhruba Charan Behera, attender by the Management of M/s. IPINIT Vanaspati Limited, Jagatpur, Cuttack with effect from the 12th August 1994 is legal and/or justified ? If not to what relief Shri Behera is entitled ?”

2. The workman is absent on repeated calls. No steps taken on his behalf. Similarly the management is also absent and no steps taken on its behalf. The perusal of the case record clearly emerges that both the management and the workman are absent repeatedly. In such view of the matter, a No Dispute Award is passed accordingly.
