## AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their order No. 1348—li/1(B)-142/1999-LE., dated the 21st January 2000.

“Whether the termination of services of Shri Gadadhar Chand, CLR Labour (unskilled) with effect from the 1st February 1998 by the Executive Engineer, Puri P. W. D. (R. & B.) Division, Puri by way of refusal of employment is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief Shri Chand is entitled ?”

2. The workman is absent on repeated calls. No steps taken on his behalf. Similarly the management is also absent and no steps taken on its behalf. The perusal of the case record clearly emerges that both the management and the workman are absent repeatedly. In such view of the matter, a no dispute award is passed accordingly.
