1. This case arises out of the reference made by the Government of Orissa, Labour & Employment Department under section 10 & 12 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 vide memo. No. 10617(5), dated 5-11-2003 for adjudication of the disputes given below :

"Whether the action of the management of SAIL, Rourkela Steel Plant, Rourkela in imposing the punishment of removal from service of the company on Shri Keshab Chandra Behera vide order No. 92850-PL-TRM/PS., dt. 21-11-1992 is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief Sri Behera is entitled ?"

The Second-party workman neither filed his statement of claim nor took any step in the Court as per order of the State Government, Labour & Employment Department contained in the reference and also on issue of repeated notices from the Court.
