This is case arises out of the reference made by the Government of Orissa, Labour & Employment Department under sections 10 & 12 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 vide memo. No. 17539(5), dated 20-12-2001 for adjudication of the disputes given below:

“ Whether the action of the management of I.D.L Industries Ltd., Sonaparbat, Rourkela-16 in imposing the punishment of dismissal from services of the company on Shri P. Tigga Employment No. 3855 with effect from 31 -3-1999 is legal and/or justified ? If not to what relief Shri Tigga is entitled ?”

2 After filing of Statement of claim and written statement by the 2nd party workman and 1st party management respectively, they did not attend the Court nor took any step inspite of repeated adjournments. As it appears, they are not interested to proceed further with the present dispute and hence, I do hereby pass a “No Dispute Award” so far the present reference is concerned.
