AWARD

1. This case arises out of the reference made by the Government of Orissa, Labour & Employment Department under Sections 10 & 12 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 vide memo No. 2170 (5)-L.E., dated the 16th February 2002 for adjudication of the dispute Scheduled below :—

“Whether the dismissal of Shri Alekh Behera from services by the management of M/s. Sambalpuri Bastralaya Handloom Co-op. Societies Ltd., Bargarh with effect from the 23rd November 1998 is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief Shri Behera is entitled ?”

2. After filing of statement of claim and written statement by the workman and management respectively, both parties did not appear subsequently in the Court nor taken any step inspite of repeated notices to them. As it appears, they are not interested to proceed with the present case. Hence, I do hereby pass a ‘No Dispute Award’, so far as the dispute under the present reference is concerned.
