AWARD

1. This case arises out of the reference made by the Government of Orissa, Labour & Employment Department under Sections 10 & 12 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 for vide memo No. 2647(5)-L.E., dated the 12th March 2004 for adjudication of disputes scheduled below :—

“Whether the termination of services of Shri Prafulla Kumar Gouda by the management of Keseibahal Large Sized Multipurpose Co-operative Societies Ltd., Keseibahal with effect from the 1st October 1997 is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief the workman Shri Gouda is entitled ?”

2. After filing of statement of claim and written statement by the workman and management respectively, both parties did not appear in the Court subsequently nor taken any step inspite of repeated notices to them. As it appears, they are not interested to proceed with the present case. Hence, I do hereby pass “No Dispute Award” so far as the dispute under the present reference is concerned.
