This case arise out of the reference made by the Government of Orissa, Labour & Employment Department under Sections 10 & 12, of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 , vide Memo No. 8137(5), dated the 21st August 2003 for adjudication of disputes scheduled below :—

“Whether the termination of services of Shri Harihar Sahoo, Peon with effect from the 8th July 2000 by the mamnagement of Talcher municipality is legal and/ or justified ? If not, what relief tis Shri Sahoo entitled to for the period of his non-employment i. e. from the 8th July 2000 to the 28th February 2001 ?”

The second party nither filed his statement of claim nor took any step in the Court as per order of the State Government, Labour & Employment Department contained in the reference and also on issue of repeated notices and inspite of repeated adjournments from the Court. as it appears, the workman is not interested to proceed with the present case. Hence I do hereby pass a “No Dispute Award” so far as the present reference is concerned.
