AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No. 859-LE., dated the 24th January 2004 :—

“Whether the action of the management of M/s. Ispat Alloys Limited, Balgopalpur, Balasore in suspending their six workmen Sarbasree Shri Manmath Panda, shri sunil Sarkar, Shri L. K. Jena, shri B. M. Mardaraj, Shri Ashok Kumar Choudhury and Shri R. P. Padhi with effect from the 20th September 2000 is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief they are entitled ?”

2. The concerned workman are absent on repeated calls. No steps taken on their behalf. The management is also absent. The case is posted today for hearing. No prayer is also made by the either party to adjourn the case to some other date for hearing. On perusal of the case record, it is seen that, the workmen are absent since the 3rd February 2004. Hence a No dispute Award possible is passed accordingly.
