AWARD

The Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department in exercise of powers conferred upon them by sub-section (5) of Section 12, read with clause (d) of sub-section (1) of Section 10 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 (14 of 1947) have referred the following dispute for adjudication vide their Order No. 10109-LE., dated the 23rd august 2002 :—

“Whether the action of M/s Modern Services a Contractors Estt. engaged in M/s Birla Tyres Chhanapur, Balasore in refusing employment to Shri susanta Kumar Behera, Contract Labourer with effect from the 11th April 1999 is legal and/or justified ? If not, what relief he is entitled to ?”

2. The concerned workman are absent on repeated calls. No steps taken on his behalf. The management are also absent. The case is posted to today for hearing. No prayer is also made by the either party to adjourn the case to some other date for hearing. On perusal of the case record, it is seen that, the workman is absent since the 26th October 2005. The concerned workman is also absent today. Hence a No dispute Award possible is passed accordingly.
