AWARD

This case arises out of the reference made by the Government of Orissa, Labour & Employment Department under Sections 10 & 12 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 vide Memo. No. 1475(5)-LE., dated the 15th February 2003 for adjudication of the disputes scheduled below :-

“ Whether the termination of services of Shri Daitari Majhi, with effect from the 1st January 1988 by the management of Kuibahal Service Co-op. Society Ltd. is legal and / or justified ? If not, to what relief Shri Majhi is entitled ?”

2. In pursuance to the Order of the Govt. of Orissa, Labour & Employment Department, the second party workman filed his statement of claim. But subsequently, the second party workman neither appeared the Court nor taken any step inspite of repeated notices to him. So, also the first party Management neither appeared nor filed any written statement in pursuance of receipt of notice sent to him by Regd. Post. As it appears both parties are not interested to proceed with the present case. Hence, I do hereby pass a ‘No Dispute Award’ so far as the dispute under the present reference is concerned.
