**S.R.O. No. 138/2006**— Whereas the draft of certain rules, further to amend the Orissa Boiler Attendants' Rules, 1956 was published as required by sub-section (1) of section 31 of the Indian Boilers Act, 1923 (5 of 1923), in the extra ordinary issue No.1856 of the *Orissa Gazette*, dated the 9th November 2005 bearing S.R.O.No.542/2005, under the notification of the Government of Orissa in the Labour & Employment Department No.9536-LL-II-FM-93/05-LE., dated the 8th November 2005 inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby, till the expiry of a period of three months from the date of publication of the said notification in the *Orissa Gazette*;

And whereas, no objection or suggestion was received during the stipulated period of three months in respect of the said draft;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 29 of the said Act, the State Government do hereby make the following rules further to amend the Orissa Boiler Attendants' Rules, 1956, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Orissa Boiler Attendants' (Amendment) Rules, 2006.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Orissa Gazette*.
2. In the Orissa Boiler Attendants' Rules, 1956, in rule 35, for sub-rule (c), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:—

“(c) Produces from the head of an industrial or technical institution duly recognized by the State Government, a certificate stating that he has completed a two years course of study having theoretical and practical training in operation and maintenance of boilers”
