AWARD

This is a reference under Section 10(1) read with Section 12(5) of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 made by the State Government of Orissa, in their Labour & Employment Department memo No. 9035(5)-L.E., dated the 11th October 2004 for adjudication of the dispute mentioned below:

SCHEDULE

“Whether the action of the Secretary, Narasingha Mahavidyalaya, Tarabhata, Koraput is refusing employment to Smt. K. Eswariamma, Ex-Peon with effect from the 3rd July 1997 is legal and/or justified ? If not, to what relief she is entitled ?”

1. After receiving the reference from the Government, the second party workman is noticed for filing her statement of claims, etc. Accordingly the second party workman is present on the 9th February 2005 and prays for an adjournment for filing her statement of claims. After that the second party workman is not turned nor takes steps for filing her statement of claims. It appears that the workman is not interested to persue of her case and it appears, she has no dispute at present. Hence the ‘No Dispute Award’ is passed.
